Jim Angleton advises that in all probability [redacted] will raise the following two points when you see him at 5:30 this afternoon. STA

1. The question put to Mr. Hoover regarding whether he desired to take over CIA activities in Latin America was put to him by Robert Kennedy and not Secretary Rusk.

2. Mr. Hoover is most upset over the "loose handling" of high-grade FBI intelligence reports sent to CIA. Apparently information from these reports has appeared in DD/I publications and in one or two instances these publications have been disseminated to friendly governments (unspecified). In this connection, Jim tells me that Dick Bissell has just today signed a memo to Bob Amory about this.
