In the spirit of the provisions of NSAM 131, it is my pleasure to invite the Agency for International Development to nominate two officers to attend.

The course is for senior officers who are assigned or will be assigned to command, staff, country team, and departmental positions, and to counterinsurgency programs in the critical countries. The course will cover the missions and responsibilities of CIA and of the other departments and agencies whose activities are coordinated in the Government's counterinsurgency programs. Emphasis will be placed on U.S. policy objectives in the target countries and on the problems, tactics, and techniques of combatting communist subversion and insurgency in these areas.
