Hans-Jurgen Robert Andree was a "Walk-In" to the U. S.

Embassy [redacted] claiming to be a Soviet Agent in possession of sensitive electronics equipment which he wished to sell to the United States. He gave the story that he was recruited in East Germany and then sent to West Germany and the United States on special assignments. He was thoroughly debriefed by [redacted] and his group and, after a number of flaws began to appear in his story, a check was made with the F. B. I. whd found out that Andree had actually stolen this equipment from a U. S. firm. The equipment was valued at \$17,000.
