

Congressman Frank M. Clark has forwarded your Form 57 to us with a letter explaining your interest in an assignment overseas.

We are glad to know of your interest in our work and appreciate your offer to serve as a member of our organization. Before considering your application further, however, we want to clarify the possibilities of an overseas assignment for you. 


