Her retirement was approved by the Civil Service Commission upon our application after she had declined to apply for disability retirement on her own behalf.

Miss [redacted] does not have reemployment rights in this Agency or in any other Government agency. At such time as she is fully recovered from her disability, she will be eligible to compete in regular civil service examinations for any position for which she might be qualified.
