

SUBJECT: Unauthorized Disclosure of Classified Intelligence
Information

In accordance with the memorandum from the Special Assistant to the President for National Security Affairs to the Director of Central Intelligence, dated 26 September 1958, this is to advise you of the results of investigation conducted by the United States Intelligence Board member agencies concerning the articles "Facts About the Missile Balance" by Joseph Alsop and "Soviet Missile Strength Overrated" by Drew Pearson appearing respectively in the 25 September 1961 and 19 October 1961 issues of the Washington Post.
