

PRESIDENT'S FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE ADVISORY BOARD

Dear John:

In accordance with arrangements which you kindly made with General Taylor, the Gray-Langer-Murphy Panel of the Board was given an excellent briefing on May 11, 1962 by Mr. Thomas Parrott on a number of the subjects which have occupied the attention of the Special NSC 5412/2 Group during the past six months.

On June 20 at 9:00 A.M., the Panel members will reconvene in Washington to further inform themselves of current covert action operations. Accordingly, the Board would be deeply grateful if you would arrange appropriate briefings by Agency personnel on significant programs in the covert action operations field which were not covered in Mr. Parrott's presentation.

The Panel will make a report to the Board on this subject at the June 25-26 meeting, and it is my hope that in the course of that two-day session the Board will have an opportunity to discuss aspects of the subject with you and, possibly, the Chairman of the Special NSC 5412/2 Group.
