1. Attached is the semi-annual report on the status of actions taken to date in further implementing the recommendations of subject report. In preparing this report consultations were held among members of this Agency and those of the Departments of State and Defense; these Departments have prepared separate reports.

2. Recommendations 14 and 33 do not require continuing action and should be dropped from future reports. Further, I would suggest that the requirement for sending semi-annual reports be abolished, and that only oral reports on implementation of basic recommendations be required in the future.
