

MEMORANDUM FOR: General Carter

SUBJECT : Report on Grants for Scientific Research

1. This memorandum suggests action on the part of the DDCI; this action is contained in paragraph 4.

2. The Congress approved legislation in 1958 that permitted the head of each agency to, among other things, make grants to nonprofit institutions of higher education for the support of basic scientific research. The head of each agency "shall make an annual report . . . (setting forth) the number of grants . . . the dollar amount of such grants, and the institutions in which title to equipment was vested"

3. The report is referred to the House Committee on Government Operations and the Senate Committee on Science and Astronautics. We understand that this report is used only by the Committees and is not published.

4. The Fiscal Year 1963 report, covering a language translation grant, is attached for your signature.




