SUBJECT: Senator Gaylord Nelson (D., Wisconsin)

1. This memorandum contains a recommendation submitted for approval of the Deputy Director of Central Intelligence. Such recommendation is contained in paragraph 3.

2. Senator Nelson has expressed a very great interest in knowing a little bit more about the Agency and would like very much to come out and visit the Agency and learn more about it.
