SUBJECT : Employee Debts

25 YEAR RE-REVIEW

The Inspector General is currently handling one case involving an Agency employee [redacted] who has accumulated a large volume of debts and who has failed to file any Federal income-tax returns over several years. It occurs to me that one area in which we could keep some degree of surveillance on this problem would be in both the exit interviews of those going overseas PCS and the returnee interviews conducted by the Office of Security, or, if this is not all inclusive, then perhaps we should establish a system for interviews by Personnel, Security or the Inspector General. Would you check on this matter and let me know your views, please?
