I would like to call your special attention to numbers, 6, page 24; 9, page 36; 16, page 66; and 22, page 89, which concern the language capabilities of field installations; to numbers 1, page 9; 10, page 38; and 13, page 50, dealing with cover matters, and to number 20, page 81, which recommends retention of [redacted]
