

SUBJECT: Conversation with Gen. Cassidy, 3 July 1957

2. Gen. Cassidy said the Board would be most interested in having a copy of the answers to Senator Sheppard's "46 Questions." He asked that this be accepted as a request from the Chairman of the Board.

4. He is quite pleased with the indoctrination he is receiving in the DD/I area. He questions the need for DD/I representatives in overseas installations. He had no specific units in mind but, speaking in general terms, said he could not understand why it was necessary to have DD/I people doing things overseas which, in his opinion, could be handled by DD/P.
