1. This memorandum contains a recommendation for your approval in paragraph 3.

2. The Deputy Director/Plans has submitted, through us, the claim of [redacted] for compensation for personal property lost in a warehouse fire while [redacted] was serving overseas. The warehouse apparently was uninsured and the fact that [redacted] himself was not carrying insurance has resulted in his losing his possessions. [redacted] contends that inasmuch as the Agency made the arrangements for the storage we should accept the liability for his loss. The Headquarters Board of Survey has examined the claim and turned it down. [redacted] has now appealed to you for a reversal of this decision. The Deputy Director/Support has reviewed the decision of the Board of Survey and concurs in it. We have also reviewed the decision and concur in it.
