SUBJECT : Review of Baker Committee Recommendations

1. General Cassidy has advised me that Doctor Baker and some of the members of his committee will be in Washington on 14 May, and have expressed a desire to meet with the interested members of USCIB to clarify any misunderstanding that may exist in regard to the Baker Committee recommendations. No time and place has yet been established for this meeting, but the AD/CI may wish to ask the Secretary of USCIB to poll the members of the Board and determine how many would like to meet with the Baker Committee. I am advised that Doctor Baker discussed some of these matters with NSA personnel at Murray Hill.

2. I would appreciate it if you could advise me by 13 May as to who would like to attend. As soon as Doctor Baker is in town I will try to establish the time and place for the meeting.
