1. This meeting was convened in order to straighten out apparent misunderstandings between Grogan's office and OO as to whether the latter was required to report to Grogan on contacts with press media.

2. It was agreed by those present that:

a. [redacted] would call Grogan's office to advise him personally of any contacts to be made with the press; it would not be necessary to state the purpose of the contact over the phone, but Col. Grogan would be advised either directly or in writing at a later time; these contacts were to include not only those as a result of specific requirements, but also the regular contacts made for regular collection purposes;

b. Col. Grogan, in turn, will keep the Office of the Chief, Contact Division, advised of relations of members of the press which might arise in OO/C discussions with the parent offices.
