SUBJECT : Inspector General's Survey of the Junior Officer Training Program

1. At the specific request of the Deputy Director for Support and the Director of Training, this Staff has just conducted a survey of the Junior Officer Training Program. The results of this survey are incorporated in the attached report submitted for your consideration and approval.

2. Although the survey of this Program noted several specific deficiencies which should be corrected, the Director of Training has done an excellent job in the establishment of the Program and the development of its basic concepts. The Program has clearly demonstrated the effectiveness of this type of approach to the procurement and career development of professional personnel to fulfill the Agency's needs. The JOF trainees inducted under this Program have proven to be outstanding employees and it is the consensus of a majority of Agency executives that the Program should be expanded to provide additional personnel of this calibre. A planned program of gradual expansion is included in this survey report.

3. Attached for your signature is a memorandum to the Deputy Director (Support) requesting that he provide you with his comments on the implementing recommendations in this report no later than 15 March 1956.
