



MEMORANDUM FOR: General Marshall S. Carter, DDCI

Attached is a memorandum from Amory discussing the proper location of the Office of Scientific Intelligence (OSI). As you know, this office has been under DDI for a considerable time. With the establishment of DDR, the question has arisen as to the feasibility of locating OSI under DDR. The principal argument for making this move is to concentrate scientific capabilities under one office. The argument against is that OSI is an important part of the estimative processes and therefore an essential tool for DDI.
