

MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR

1. This memorandum is for information only.

2. General Tom Phillips telephoned today to offer you his congratulations upon your continuing as Director of CIA. He is delighted not only that you are continuing, but also that this establishes a policy of not changing the head of CIA when a new President is elected.

3. Phillips is quite put out about "The U-2 Story" by NBC on Tuesday, 29 November 1960. He said NBC paid him some \$300 and spent six hours at his house where they had a general discussion of the U-2 and he had about a minute and a half on the air, merely touching on what he had said on the elements of the cover statement. He didn't know how much of the conversation they recorded would be used. He didn't like the presentation, particularly since it was pegged on two points:

- (1) Make the Eisenhower Administration look bad.
- (2) Make America look bad because of the inept handling of the cover story.

4. He hopes that you don't think that he participated knowing that the overall handling of the subject was to be anchored to those two points. He said it wasn't worth \$300 to him to have participated in such a sorry picture.
