Thank you for your letter of 9 February expressing your interest in civilian service with this Agency.

You would be welcome to visit the Agency at a convenient time to discuss your qualifications but in view of the present unpromising prospects for your joining us, we feel that we would simply be imposing on your time. Most of our new employees come in as clerical workers or junior officers and our more senior positions are filled by promotion of careerists. When we do look outside of the Agency to fill a particular spot at the higher levels, we are seeking a man with professional accomplishments in the particular field for which we are recruiting. As matters now stand, there is no immediate requirement for a man of your very considerable experience.

We are appreciative of the assets represented in senior retired officers and have obtained special legislative authorization to employ such individuals in spite of general restrictions governing their civilian employment by the Government. However, the number of such assignments we may make is limited and the authorization is usually fully obligated. This could present a problem in the event an opening commensurate with your background should develop.

Thank you again for giving us the opportunity to consider your qualifications. If something of apparent mutual interest should develop, we shall get in touch with you.


