

Respectable and Dear Mr. Dulles,

My frequent correspondence to you would seem as a sign of impudence. But it would be tragic-like for Americans and of high rank ones if you do not believe that we your friends have in mind nothing else but their economic and narrow personal interests and troubles. It would be improper here to enumerate what we - your friends are doing, writing and spending every day in order to help in the dealy struggle for survival and against Communism. You could not believe if you had the opportunity to read one even letter from behind the iron curtain and see for yourselves the truth. Simultaneously we are working on subjects which will take very long time to be completed, and very wide destination and we hope to be proud of them later on.

Of course all these things we are saying might seem to you - American suspicious since they are put forth by persons coming from the realm of Communism and thus the possibility of a possible Communist deceit arises every time. But what we can do except to go ahead and work and work again.

Of such a "dubious" nature is also the question that I have to refering to you. This is the case of Mr. Hristo Ikilulev a hard anti-Communist, a devoted friend of the U.S. and of all that is American. Alas, he has been slandered by Communists and pro-Communists and now is degenerating in force and losing the last faith in all that is American. His letters are ones of desperation. You have to read them to see what some American officials are doing, under the pretext of fear from Communism, of discovering its agents and of serving the cause of freedom. The tragedy becomes still more devastating because he has been completely rehabilitated by the French authorities and because parallel to his letters I am called by the phone ~~from~~ by his relatives and friends, all humble and uneducated people asking me to help him since his letters are breaking their hearts. To me it is very clear that immigrants have never been in respect and authority in any country throughout the history. Some exception maybe is making the USSR. I do not blame for that the Americans for it is more than natural that every body wishes to be boss in his own fatherland and that such an attitude is biologically and even ethically justified. But the disaster comes from the fact that the world is already, for little one, that it's divided in two, the one portion being deadly enemy of the other and that this portion represented by Communism is gaining mostly because of the mistakes of us - the Christians and freedom lovers. And one of these mistakes is Ikilulev's sufferings and those of his family.

Dear Mr. Dulles, I do not have what more to say but to most cordially and instantly ask you to try to help those people come to this country! Please be kind to help and help in time. Useless and senseless are the sufferings and the desperations. If you do not do that, if you do not help, who else would? No body, I personally, have no faith in no body, because the other of the high ranking officials in this administration seems to have the dedication and the biological capacity to see the truths and act accordingly.

P.S. I apologize for admittin'g in my first letter, such an unconvincin'g error as writing "sitizen" instead of "citizen"
