Dear Allen:

The Inter-American Defense Board (IADB) is charged with military planning of the common defense of the United States and the Latin-American nations of this Hemisphere. In the performance of my duties as Chairman of the IADB, I am assisted by an International Staff of 22 field grade officers, headed by Brigadier General William K. Skaer, USAF. The Staff meets daily to draw up plans and studies, as directed, for review by the Board's Council of Delegates which is composed of senior representatives from the twenty-one American Republics.

I have felt for some time that the IADB presents an unusual opportunity to acquaint the leaders and the future leaders in Latin America with some basic concepts bearing upon the threat of international communism posed by the Soviet Union to the security of this Hemisphere. For this reason, in confirmation of informal coordination effected through the good offices of your Deputy for Intelligence, Mr. Robert Amory, Jr., I request that a series of presentations, classified through CONFIDENTIAL, be given in English at the IADB to my Staff every week beginning in early October. Members of the Council of Delegates will also be invited to attend these presentations.

The following subjects appear to me particularly appropriate: Basis of Communist Thought; Development and Status of Communist Organization; Communist Strategy and Tactics; The Communist Movement Today; Soviet Economy, Resources, Trade, and Industry; and World Objectives of the USSR.

I shall be very pleased if you suggest the addition of further briefings. For example, I shall be delighted if you wish to include a briefing on the U. S. intelligence community, with attention focused on the organization, mission and functions of the Central Intelligence Agency. Such a subject might appropriately initiate the series of presentations.
