

Tenafly is very easy to get to from New York, as it is conveniently located just five miles from the George Washington Bridge. Many of our members live in Tenafly and have their work in New York.


There are about 2300 members in our church and about 1000 in our Men's Club. You would have an appreciative and attentive audience.
