

SUBJECT : Organization and Functions

1. Effective 15 September 1958, Mr. Huntington D. Sheldon, will, as CIA COMINT Officer (a) advise and assist the Director of Central Intelligence in the formulation, implementation and coordination of COMINT policies; (b) coordinate the CIA COMINT program; (c) provide centralized guidance for the conduct of CIA COMINT activities, in accordance with policies established by USIB; and (d) act for the DCI in COMINT matters, as appropriate. This responsibility does not supersede or alter established over-all responsibilities of the Deputy Director (Coordination) as set forth in Agency Regulation 1-150.

2. Agency Regulations [redacted] will be amended appropriately.



SUBJECT : Organizational Changes Stemming from Revised NSCID Nos. 1 and 6

1. This memorandum contains a recommendation submitted for Director of Central Intelligence approval. Such recommendation is contained in paragraph 3.

2. Revised NSCID 1 provides that the Director of Central Intelligence will be the CIA representative on, as well as Chairman of, USIB. Certain revisions of Agency Regulations will be necessary in order to regularize the basic authorization from the Director for the execution of CIA COMINT responsibilities.
