1. [Redacted] and John B. Warner met with Donald Henderson of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee staff as a result of the Director's letter to Senator Fulbright responding to his query on the [Redacted] case. Also present were Mr. Guenther from G-2 and Colonel Goodwin from Army L&L.

3. It was also pointed out that for several years there had been a complete bar on briefing Fulbright scholars prior to trips behind the Iron Curtain and presently there are bars against such briefings for all Americans. This seemed to ease the situation in Mr. Henderson's mind.

4. Mr. Henderson was also requested to classify as **SECRET** the letter from Mr. Dulles to Senator Fulbright. Mr. Henderson stated that he would be happy to do so. He will also personally brief the Chairman and Carl Marcy, Chief of Staff.

5. The Army will classify Mr. Dulles' correspondence with General Willems and the copies they received of the DCI letter to Fulbright. [redacted] was advised in general of the results of the meeting including the request that he have Executive Registry classify the correspondence appropriately.
