MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD:

Ambassador Lacy called me today with regard to my communication to him, as Chairman of USIB, of 18 January 1959, approving the idea of a Guided Missiles Exchange Proposal with the Soviet Union. In view of the lapse of time, Ambassador Lacy merely desired to know whether there had been any change in our views in the meantime.

I consulted with General Cabell, and informed Ambassador Lacy that we saw no reason to change our views as expressed in that letter, and had had no indication from any USIB source that they wished to change the position.
