Dear Mr. Dodge:

I am answering your letter of 9 December to Mr. Dulles in which you recommended that [redacted] receive a promotion. The matter has been carefully reviewed by our Supergrade Review Board, and I am happy to inform you that favorable action has been taken. Because of certain limitations on the number of supergrades the Agency can carry at any one time, the promotion is necessarily effective for the period of [redacted] service with your Council. I can assure you, as I have [redacted] personally, that when he returns to CIA every effort will be made to find him a position in grade appropriate to his high qualifications.
