Dear Governor Adams:

Reference is made to my letter dated 15 June 1955 concerning certain allegations against employees of this Agency which your office received from the Hoover Commission, and which you turned over to this Agency on 2 June 1955.

I wish to inform you that the case of [redacted] has been considered by senior officials in the Central Intelligence Agency, and I have approved their findings that Mr. [redacted] is eligible for Government employment under the provisions of Executive Order 10450.

Mr. [redacted] is no longer a staff employee, and it is not intended to re-employ him at this time. We are contemplating his use in a covert project of interest to this Agency.

This case concludes the adjudication under EO 10450 of the four cases mentioned in my referenced letter. I am pleased to report that investigation and board hearings failed to find substance to the allegations made in these cases and were resolved in favor of the employee.
