MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Intelligence Briefing of Senator Kefauver, 7 October 1956

1. Senator Kefauver was briefed at his Washington residence (4929 Hillbrook Lane, N. W.) on Sunday, 7 October 1956. It was the second intelligence briefing of the Senator and lasted approximately one hour, from 2:45 to 3:45 p.m.

2. Senator Kefauver read all articles in the prepared briefing, giving particular attention to those on the Khrushchev-Tito Talks, Suez, Soviet Foreign Aid, and Soviet Reactor Program. He asked questions about each of these topics. On Soviet Reactors he commented that he had visited the Reactor at Obninskoye and had been shown the site of a 100,000 KW Reactor for which ground had been broken. Senator Kefauver questioned the statement that the Obninskoye Reactor was inefficient.

3. [redacted] will make the arrangements for the next briefing, which may be Sunday, 14 October, in Washington.
