LIAISON WITH PRESIDENT'S BOARD
OF CONSULTANTS ON FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES

1. The office of the Inspector General has been designated as the focal point for all liaison with the President's Board of Consultants on Foreign Intelligence Activities.
2. All material prepared for the Board should be transmitted to that office for release. This applies both to material requested by the Board and such information as may voluntarily be submitted.
3. Generally speaking, requests from the Board for information will be transmitted to the Agency through the office of the Inspector General. In the event that a request should come through a different channel, that office should be advised immediately.
4. In transmitting material for the Board, only an original is required for the Board and only one copy is required for the office of the Inspector General which will maintain a central file of all material transmitted to the Board. When sending the material to the Inspector General please note whether the Director has seen the material or has requested to see it prior to transmission so that this may be accomplished if necessary.
