**SUBJECT:** Current Status of Activities of the President's  
Board of Consultants on Foreign Intelligence  
Activities

1. As a result of its meeting on 12 May the Board has formally requested by letter six actions on the part of the Agency. Each of these will be covered by separate memorandum.

2. Two trips are scheduled for the immediate future by the Board:

3. The Board has arrived at a primary allocation of specialties along the following lines:

a. Dr. Killian will cover operations, planning for research and planning for technical services research.

b. Mr. Lovett and General Hull will cover plans and policy-- this to include planning for clandestine operations.

c. Admiral Conolly will cover training and education and personnel.

d. Mr. Ryerson and Mr. Fairless will cover organization.

e. Mr. Kennedy will cover budget and fiscal.

f. General Deolittle will cover security (and possibly operations).


