

BACKGROUND

SINO-INDIAN TREATY OF 29 APRIL 1954
ON TIBET

- I. Chinese position on Tibet, communicated to Indian Ambassador Peiping December 1953 prior opening negotiations re Sino-Indian treaty.
 - A. China will not tolerate further Indian interest Tibet.
 - B. Indian borders with Tibet must be compatible wishes border people, especially those Tibetan extraction.
 - C. No objection must be made by India to Chinese construction forts in Tibet near Indian and Nepalese borders.
 - D. India must adopt strong policy to eradicate illegal activities foreign agents working Indian side border.
 - E. Chinese soldiers and civilians crossing into Nepal are not to be molested.
 - F. India not to lend support anyone who might take question Tibet to UN.
