Dear Senator Hill:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated
7 February 1956 concerning reemployment possibilities for
Mr. [redacted].

Mr. [redacted] was employed by this Agency from 9
November 1951 to 24 January 1955. Although his services
were acceptable initially, they were only marginal during the
last year of his employment. Mr. [redacted] had been reprimanded in January 1954 and again in early January 1955 for
his absence without leave, and was warned that a third offense
would result in his dismissal. After his third offense, during
the middle of January 1955, Mr. [redacted] resigned before
formal charges were brought against him.

While I appreciate your interest in assisting Mr. [redacted]
and in calling my attention to an interested candidate for employ-
ment, Mr. [redacted] prior service demonstrates that he lacks
necessary qualifications of reliability and dependability.
Accordingly, no encouragement can be given to Mr. [redacted] as
to possible reemployment by this Agency.
