



Dear Senator Kefauver:

Thank you for your letter of 31 May concerning the application of Mr.  for employment with this Agency.

Mr.  was interviewed by our Personnel Office on 20 April, at which time he supplied us with the necessary application forms. During the interview, Mr.  was informed of our policy which requires that an applicant presently employed in another Government agency must obtain a statement of availability from that agency. He was also advised that we are doing relatively little hiring at the level in which he is interested. Since we heard nothing further from him, we assumed that he had considered it best not to request a letter of availability from his present employer.

We have retained Mr.  application and, should he choose to provide the necessary statement of availability, we shall be glad to give his application further consideration.

We have your letter dated 31 May 1956 concerning
Mr. [redacted] of Washington, D. C.

Mr. [redacted] was interviewed in our offices on 20 April 1956 at which time he supplied us with the usual application forms. He was not, however, aware of our requirement that he must obtain a statement from his present U. S. Government employer of a willingness for us to consider his application. We adhere strictly to this requirement and so informed Mr. [redacted]. Since we have not received the statement we have not given his application further consideration.
