



Dear Mrs. Church:

I refer to your letter of 29 March 1957, and to my interim reply of 4 April 1957, relative to certain observations by one of your constituents concerning the Natsionalno-Trudovoi Soyuz or National Labor Union (NTS).

We have examined into the facts concerning the activities of the NTS, and we find that there are a number of statements in the letter from your constituent which do not accord with the information available to us. The history of this organization and its activities is a complicated one. I would suggest that if you are interested in further information on the subject I should be glad to have my Legislative Counsel, Mr. Norman Paul, who will deliver this letter, give you a briefing in whatever detail you desire.

If I can be of any further assistance in this matter, please do not hesitate to let me know.
