Dear Mr. Smith:

So little time has elapsed since Mr. [redacted] about whom you wrote on 17 March, reported for work on the mechanical translation project administered by Georgetown University that I do not have any new information at this time.

Dr. Dostert, who directs the project at Georgetown, informs us that Mr. [redacted] reported there on 1 March and is now at work testing his theory. It does look as though more time than the original month arranged for may be required to allow a complete test of [redacted] theory, so it is highly likely that the trial period may be extended for an additional couple of months. We will keep you informed of the results of [redacted]'s work at Georgetown.

[redacted], who has followed [redacted] claim as well as all other mechanical translation claims and theories which have come to our attention, is out of the country at the present time. He is due to return the first of May and if you are interested in learning more about the state of the art of machine translation in general and the [redacted] theory in particular, I would be glad to have him brief you or any member of your staff who may be dealing with this problem.


