With further reference to my letter of 25 July 1959 in connection with the relationship between the Central Intelligence Agency and the General Accounting Office I should like to report that Mr. Campbell, the Comptroller General, accompanied by Mr. Heller, his General Counsel, and Mr. Samuelson, Director of the Civil Accounting and Auditing Division, GAO, attended a briefing of approximately three hours duration in my offices on 30 July 1959. This briefing included presentations by our most senior officials who are responsible to me for the conduct of our operations and financial activities.


