**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

**SUBJECT: Appearance of the Director before the CIA Subcommittee of House Armed Services Committee - 30 June 1959**

1. The Director appeared before the Kilday Subcommittee (CIA Subcommittee of House Armed Services Committee) for approximately two hours on 30 June 1959 in Room 314. Accompanying the Director were: Richard Bissell, Robert Amory, Jr., Col. L. K. White, and John S. Warner. A technical sweep was made of the room. Present from the Subcommittee were:

Since a transcript was made of the hearing some of the details will not be repeated in this memorandum.

2. The Director first took up the matter of the General Accounting Office audit of CIA activities. The Director indicated he had reviewed carefully the Comptroller General's letter and Mr. Kilday's letter and in view of the importance of the subject the Director stated he was going to take up this matter with the President. Subsequently, if the President approved, the Director would meet with Mr. Campbell. A few specific questions were asked by the members concerning vouchered funds and current GAO audit.
