SUBJECT: Travel of Senator Allen J. Ellender (D., La.)

1. This memorandum contains two recommendations submitted for approval of the Director of Central Intelligence. Such recommendations are contained in paragraph 4.

2. The attached State Department cable indicates the itinerary of Senator Ellender for an extensive trip through South America, Central



3. In July of 1958 Senator Ellender vigorously criticized us on a radio program. An excerpt of that transcript is attached. In addition, Senator Saltonstall suggested on 8 August 1958 that you should talk to the Senator. There was a clear inference at the time that Senator Ellender, among others, was seriously questioning the amount of appropriations which should be made available to the Agency.



b. I also recommend that when he returns you personally meet with Senator Ellender to discuss his trip and take advantage of that opportunity to discuss the Agency in general.
