What ever observations you make will be held as confidential and personal, and your comments will not be publicized. Your encouragement and counsel will mean much to those on the inner circle, such as Arthur Compton, Paul Hoffman, Governor Dewey, Gladys Straus and myself.

I will be in Washington August 3rd to 8th in case you wish to talk to me. But please mail me your reaction to the proposal, anyway.
