
In line with our telephone conversation, I am enclosing herewith a copy of a book and eight pamphlets or papers written by Clara J. Fonti on the subject of her cancer research. Your office had previously expressed an interest in seeing this material at the time we received a letter from a [redacted] who wrote from New Jersey. Apparently he communicated with Dr. Fonti through one Dr. Mary Voornemau, who resides in The Hague.

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Dr. Fonti delivered this material to the U. S. Consulate in Milan and it was in turn forwarded to us from there. She apparently also left with the Consulate copies of the same material to be forwarded to President Eisenhower and Attorney General Rogers. At the same time she sent a note to Mr. Allen Dulles saying that she had delivered these materials which contained all of her published formulas and findings. She also stated that she is at the complete disposal of the physicians attending Secretary Dulles.

I might add that in transmitting Dr. Fonti's book the Consulate in Milan commented that she appears to be considered a highly respectable and reputable doctor in Italy.


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I am also enclosing the original and translation of the other letter I mentioned to you from M. Paul Girard dealing with his 25 years of self-study in cosmobiology.

Dear Mr. Dulles:

I read your article about Iraq in New York Times and it seems to me very interesting to know that it started to bring some concern to us American after we learn that the Russian infiltration in progress in that country and you still believe at least as I always do believe that no Arab country will go Communist if we Americans know the remedy and the answer.

The present premier of Iraq is the same as any leader that loves his country also devoted to his post to serve the people without any foreign obligations or entanglements as in the past where so many red tape is involved where it must not be in order to assure that nation of our positive attitude Democratically.

WHY KING FEISAL, HIS UNCLE ABD AL-ALLAH, AND THE IRAQI PREMIER NURI AS-SAID WERE KILLED AND MURDERED IN AN OVER NIGHT REVOLUTIONARY COUP DE TETE, I AM SURE YOU MUST HAVE THE ANSWER.

To us Americans it is water over the Dam, but I would like to say it was our fault as well as the British by our improper application of our foreign aids intelligently and in the benefit of all the people and not just one nation which still considered in the very minority between the huge 75 millions MOSLUM.

IRAQ WILL NEVER GO COMMUNIST IF WE KNOW HOW TO HANDLE THE PROBLEM WITHOUT THE HELP OF THE BRITISH, AND I AM SURE THE ARAB WILL AGREE WITH THIS BECAUSE ENGLAND AT PRESENT IS DANCING ON THE TWO ROBES AND I AM SURE YOU MUST KNOW THE ANSWER TOO.

Trusting that you will enjoy some of my remarks and I hope some benefit you can get out of it because I am sure no Islamic nation will go Communist unless we pushed them in to it and you know how we can do, it too.
