Dear Sir:

This letter is to request kindly from you the honour of an interview.

I am a French political writer and journalist. You may find details of my activities in the attached notice.

I shall visit the United States in December and January on a Journalist Fellowship to inquire specially about the inner fabric of the American political life. As you are one of its outstanding figures, I would like very much to be able to have a talk with you. I have followed your works with great interest, and plan to dedicate to your views a place in the writings which shall come out of my trip.

I would also take the opportunity to bring to your attention important developments which are taking place in Europe in order to face the "Political War" or "War of Brains" of the Soviets, a decisive field entirely neglected until now by the Free World.

I shall be in Washington from November 30, to December 5, and in New York (at the Hotel Roosevelt) from December 5 to December 12, then back for 4 days in Washington.

- Numerous lectures in France, in Argentine, Japan, Formosa, Vietnam, India, etc.


Main political actions in the last two years:
