MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

VIA: Chief of Operations, DDP

SUBJECT: Dissemination of Information From Federal Bureau of Investigation to the Office of Current Intelligence

For your information the following procedures are currently in effect for furnishing to the Office of Current Intelligence pertinent political intelligence received from the FBI:

1. Finished intelligence reports prepared by the FBI, which include Current Intelligence Analyses, monographs and studies, are sent directly to the DDI from your office.
2. Copies of strategic political intelligence reports, which have not been overtaken by world events, are sent directly to OCI by the CI Staff, DDP, upon receipt. This action is so indicated to the Foreign Divisions of the DDP.
3. With a few exceptions, the Foreign Divisions of the DDP do not forward to OCI FBI reports in addition to those already forwarded by the CI Staff, except in connection with a specific informational request from OCI.
4. No FBI reports dealing with internal security or espionage matters are forwarded to OCI by the CI Staff.
