My understanding of the arrangements about which we talked this morning by telephone is that I shall reach Washington Tuesday evening at 6:20 P. M. on American Airlines flight #569 from New York - that I will spend Wednesday morning with your people as they may wish to dispose of my time, and that you will plan to see me at 3:30 P. M. on Wednesday afternoon, March 6th, and that if convenient, you will have dinner with me. As there is no convenient late evening flight out of Washington for Chicago, I shall plan to stay over in Washington Wednesday night and take American Airlines flight #69 from Washington for Chicago at 7:45 A. M. on Thursday, March 7th. You said that you would suggest to your secretary that she make reservations for me at the DuPont Plaza so that if she will take care of this for Tuesday night and Wednesday night, March 5th and 6th, I shall appreciate it. I am looking forward very much to seeing you.

M. on Monday, the 4th, and shall spend Monday night at the University Club at 1 West 54th Street.
