We are now really feeling the pinch of our personnel ceiling and are going through quite a readjustment to take care of those people already on duty, particularly in view of the reductions in some of our field stations. In addition, we are being pressured from all angles to consider more senior Government employees who have been released as a result of the recent economy program and I believe that it will be sometime after the first of the year before we know just where we stand and what senior vacancies we have left. For these reasons, I have not contacted either [Redacted]. I thought it far better not to do so until we had some reasonable hope of finding places for them if they should really be interested. I am sorry that I have not advised you of the situation earlier but am sure you will understand.

It was good to talk to you on the 'phone a few days ago and to learn that your recent illness has caused you no permanent disability. I hope that you will soon be up and about and that we will have the pleasure of seeing you before too long.
