MEMORANDUM

Reference: Memorandum entitled "Intelligence Activities" [redacted] forwarded as an enclosure to Bureau of the Budget letter to DCI of 12 August 1957.

1. In order to consider properly the comments and suggestions contained in reference several factors must be considered.

B. The program and activities of each CIA station are governed by a Related Mission Directive (RMD), which sets forth the area of responsibility, objectives and tasks and which specifies the order of

intelligence program for each station is generally determined by NSC directives and by requirements approved by the Interdepartmental Priorities Committee (IPC). Within the overall program as established by the RMD the station's activities are reviewed annually in their entirety and priorities are established consistent with budgetary and operational assets available. Specific projects or programs within this framework are under constant review. It was determined to be impractical to obtain an accurate evaluation of all projects at one time. Accordingly CIA provides for a periodic review of individual projects which supplements our annual program review. This is designed to evaluate the effectiveness of individual activities in relation to our overall responsibilities. Such reviews are performed each year, but at scheduled intervals which allows an even distribution of effort during

targets outside the country. Accordingly, the formulation of an overall program and the establishment of relative priorities must be done at headquarters. The objectives are often amended or changed by international developments outside the host country.

(2.c.) Most certainly there is a continuing need for review in all areas to insure that covert and overt intelligence collection is coordinated to avoid duplication of effort. In some instances corroboration may be desirable or necessary.




