MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: PSB Luncheon Meeting, 25 September 1952, at CIA

1. I took occasion to inform General Bedell Smith that [redacted] 25X1  
 [redacted], while still nominally a "Consultant" to the PSB, had not  
 received any salary since 15 September (possibly 12 September depending  
 on adjustment of leave); that [redacted] is now in the South recovering 25X1  
 his health, and we would terminate his relationship with this office  
 upon his return North. General Smith suggested that a resignation due  
 to ill health might be timely; but I said that my information was that  
 Dr. Vannevar Bush had advised [redacted] not to resign. We left the 25X1  
 matter this way with the understanding that [redacted] would eventually 25X1  
 be released by the office, if he did not resign earlier.
