





REFERENCE : a. Memorandum from DCI to DDCI, DD/P and DD/A, dated 30 January 1954, Subject: Approval of FI Projects.

b. Regulation [redacted] dated 25 February 1954, Subject: Obligation and Expenditure of Funds

1. In accordance with sub-paragraph 1. b. of reference a, the Chief, CI is authorized to approve, renew, extend and amend CI Basic Plans and Projects on a calendar year basis as delineated below:

a. Chief, CI is authorized to approve all new CI Basic Plans or Projects calling for an annual expenditure of an amount up to and including the sum of [redacted]

b. Chief, CI is authorized to approve the renewal of all CI Basic Plans or Projects calling for an annual expenditure up to and including the sum of [redacted]

c. Chief, CI is authorized to approve the amendments of all new CI Basic Plans or Projects provided such amendments do not bring the sum total authorized for the project to more than [redacted]

d. Chief, CI is authorized to approve amendments to

amendments do not bring the sum total authorized for the project to more than [] However, if approval of the amendment during the renewal year would bring the sum total of the project above the original approving officer's limitation, the requested amendment will then require the approval of higher authority as appropriate. (For example: COP-DD/P gives approval of renewal of a project costing

Prior to expiration of the project, the Division requests an amendment costing [] This amendment cannot be approved by Chief, CI or by COP-DD/P since it brings the sum total of the project cost to [] which requires DDCI approval.)

e. Chief, CI is authorized to approve the extensions of Basic Plans or Projects under the same conditions as set forth in 1. b., above, since an extension must be considered, in effect, a renewal.

f. Chief, CI is authorized to approve all terminations of Basic Plans or Projects, however, any expenses connected with termination must not exceed Chief, CI's approval limitations of [] the first year or [] in a renewal year. Expenditures to meet previously approved commitments (i. e., death and disability, resettlement, bonuses, etc.


2. All matters involving significant new policy determinations or other questions indicating the desirability of decision by higher authority, including the Director of Central Intelligence, will be properly referred for decision prior to final action, regardless of the amounts involved.

4. In accordance with sub-paragraph 8. a., reference b, appropriate approving officers are granted authority to obligate, advance, and/or expend funds to meet officially authorized expenses, within the limitations of established allotments. In the light of this regulation, and the authority granted him in first reference memorandum, the Chief, CI is authorized to advance funds in line with his authority to approve Basic Plans or Projects. As an internal measure, this authority enables the Chief, CI to authorize the advance of funds in the absence of formal approval of a plan or projects. Thus in the support of a new operation, for

MEMORANDUM FOR : Deputy Director of Central Intelligence

SUBJECT : Approval of F.I. Projects

1. Within the total amount of funds authorized for foreign intelligence purposes from the appropriations available to the Agency and within policy lines established, authority is hereby granted to approve of espionage and counterespionage operational projects, not heretofore approved under previously existing procedures, as follows:

a. The Deputy Director (Plans) may approve of any project calling for an expenditure of an amount not exceeding [redacted] in a Fiscal Year. The Chief of Operations, Office of the Deputy Director (Plans), may approve of the renewal of projects where previously approved by competent authority and the amounts involved will not exceed [redacted] in a Fiscal Year.

b. The Chief of Operations may approve of projects in amounts not exceeding [redacted] in a Fiscal Year, and may delegate in writing such authority to the Chief of Foreign Intelligence, as to individual projects involving an expenditure of less than [redacted] (The Chief of Foreign Intelligence Staff may approve of the renewal of projects where previously approved by competent authority and the amounts involved will not exceed [redacted] in a Fiscal Year.)

c. Projects involving expenditures in excess of [redacted] in a Fiscal Year will be forwarded by the Deputy Director (Plans) to the Deputy Director of Central Intelligence with DD/P recommendations for action. The Deputy Director of Central Intelligence will effect any further coordination which he deems appropriate and is authorized in his discretion to approve of any such project or refer it to the Director for determination of final action.

2. All matters involving significant new policy determinations or other questions indicating the desirability of decision by higher authority, including the Director of Central Intelligence, will

be properly referred for decision prior to final action, regardless of the amounts involved.



3. The provisions of Agency Regulation [redacted] are hereby amended to the extent that they are inconsistent with the above.
