MEMORANDUM FOR THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY, NSC

SUBJECT: Request for an additional copy of certain NSC papers

1. In order to facilitate the intelligence service rendered by CIA to the NSC Staff, it is requested that CIA be furnished one additional copy of NSC papers of the following categories:

- a. Papers referred to the NSC Staff for action which may require the preparation of an intelligence appreciation by CIA
- b. Working papers of the NSC Staff which embody intelligence appreciations in their analyses
- c. The final versions of such papers, as submitted to the NSC (as a check against distortion of their intelligence content in consultative or editorial revision).
