MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE

Subject: Cables from CINCPAC Re Implementation of the Korean Armistice

1. According to your suggestion, I spoke to General Porter. He informed me he had made an official request through channels following your conversation with him about six weeks ago, but that he had not as yet received a disposition in this matter. Under the circumstances he said he was reluctant, at this time, to pursue the matter further.

2. I am not familiar with the exact request which you levied on him earlier, but presume that it was in line with the original memorandum attached.

3. I feel that unless we have the necessary cables made available to us, we may be caught short should any trouble occur in Korea.

4. Have you any instructions for me to go back to General Porter on?

*or* . Do you intend to take the subject up directly with him?

SUBJECT: Cables from CINCUNC Re Implementation of the Korean Armistice

1. In order that this office may fulfill its responsibility for current and accurate reporting with respect to the implementation of the Korean armistice and related negotiations, it is essential that we receive on a daily basis:

- a. Cabled reports of the Korean Military Armistice Commission (MAC)
- b. Cabled reports concerning the Neutral Nations Repatriation Commission (NNRC) and the Neutral Nations Supervisory Commission (NNSC)

2. It is understood that MAC and NNRC reports will be cabled from CINCUNC directly to the Joint Chiefs of Staff. The NNSC is to report to the MAC, thus placing all reporting in CINCUNC-JCS channels.

3. Receipt of these cabled reports on a daily basis will make a significant contribution to current intelligence production. Failure in the past to receive JCS cables on the truce negotiations was a serious handicap.


